Our Mission

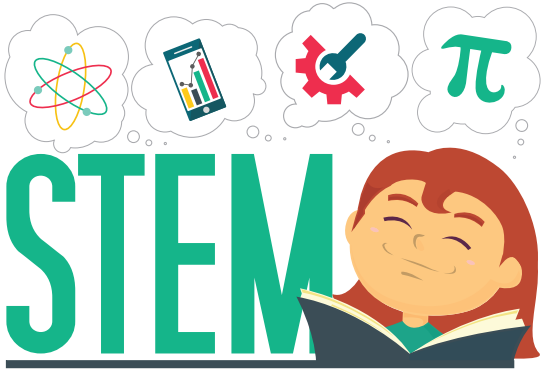
Our Mission is to inspire ALL girls to be strong, smart, and bold.

Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math programs are a cornerstone of the Girls Inc. Experience, which serve to engage and educate our next generation of STEM professionals. Girls Inc. has had a profound impact for thousands of girls in Pinellas County and your support for our STEM program and mission continues to enhance our ability to reach more girls with greater impact.

In addition to our STEM focus, Operation SMART Summer Camp provides a Summer Bridge program to combat summer learning loss, daily hot meals, interactive field trips, Talent Show, Science Fair, and Family Cookout. We are open extended hours - 6:30am-6pm - to accommodate working families. We are licensed by the Pinellas County Licensing Board for Child Care and monitored by the Department of Health Child Care Food Program.

Over half of our girls require financial assistance. Approximately 62% of our families are single parent homes and 79% are economically disadvantaged. Fundraising efforts directly benefit girls who may not otherwise be able to attend Girls Inc. through our scholarship program.
